I am a big boy now.



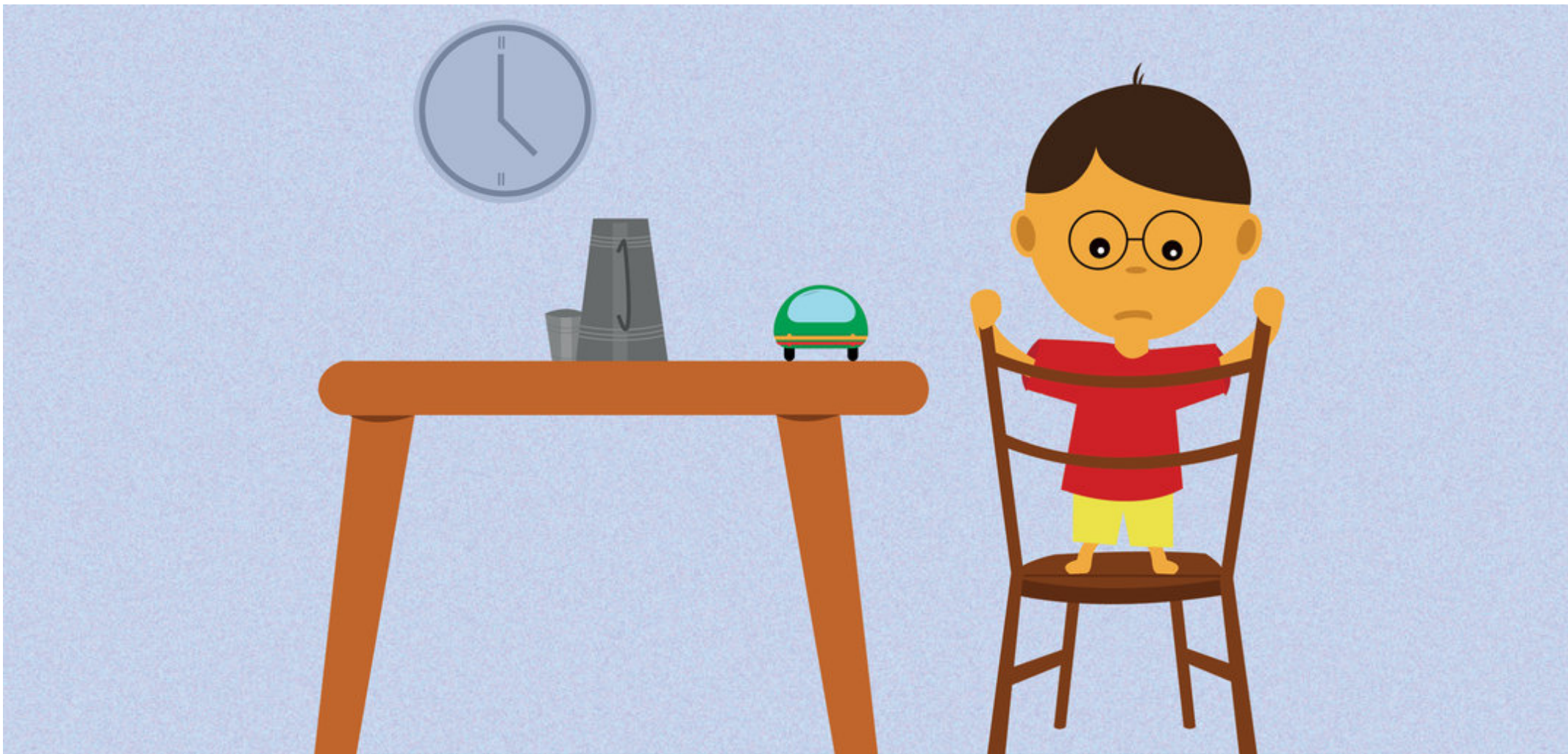
I can climb up the steps.



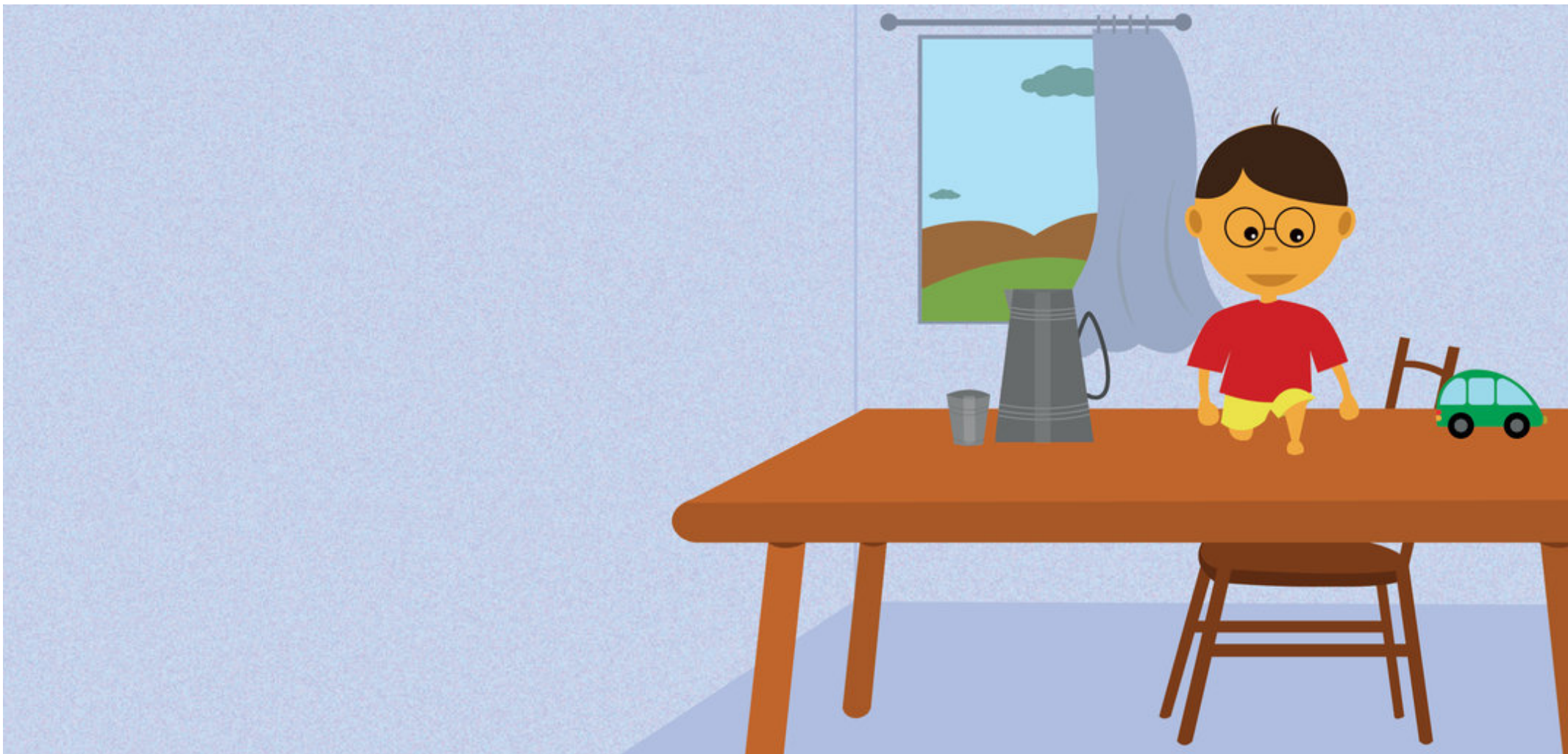
But I cannot climb down again.



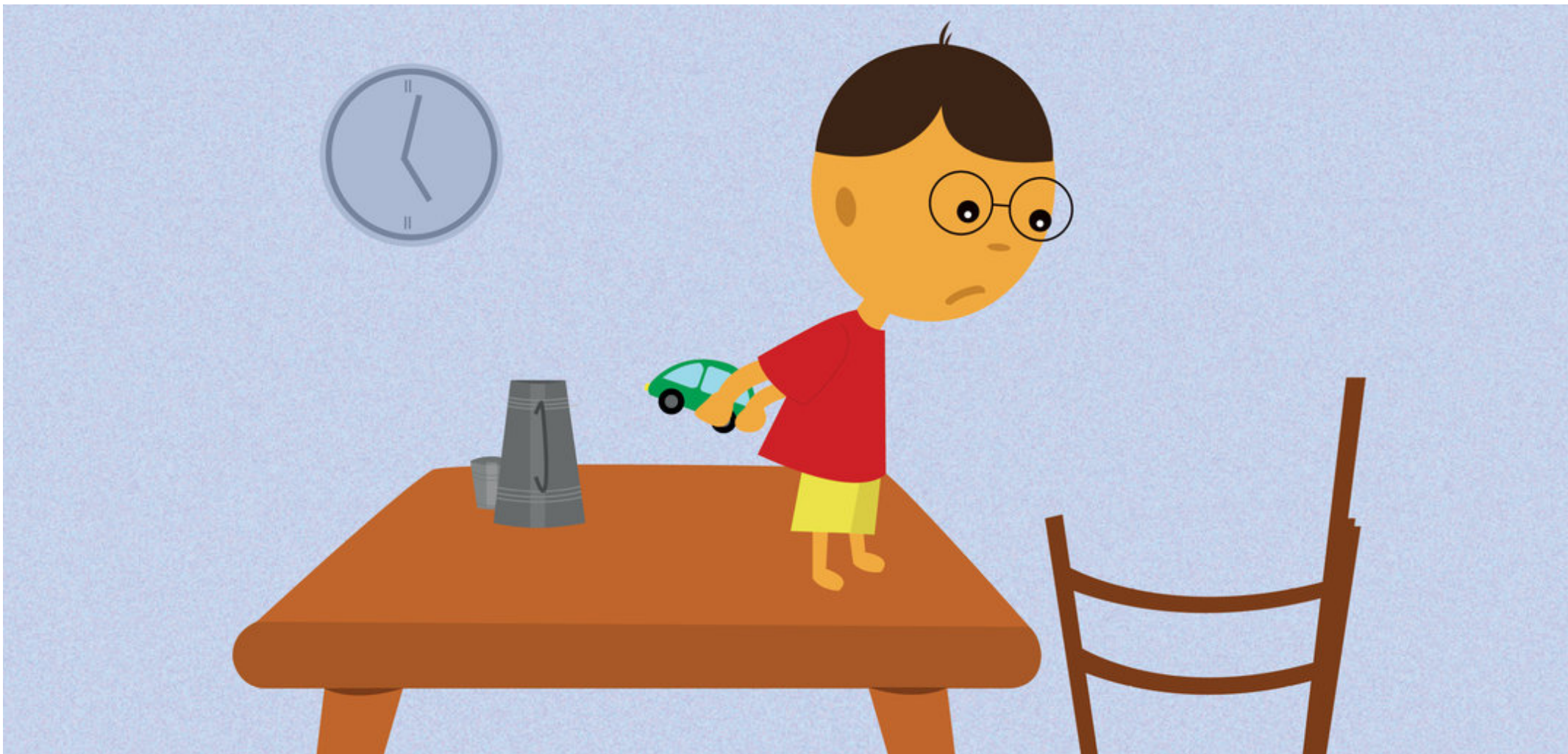
I can climb on a chair.

“Papa! Papa!” I shout.

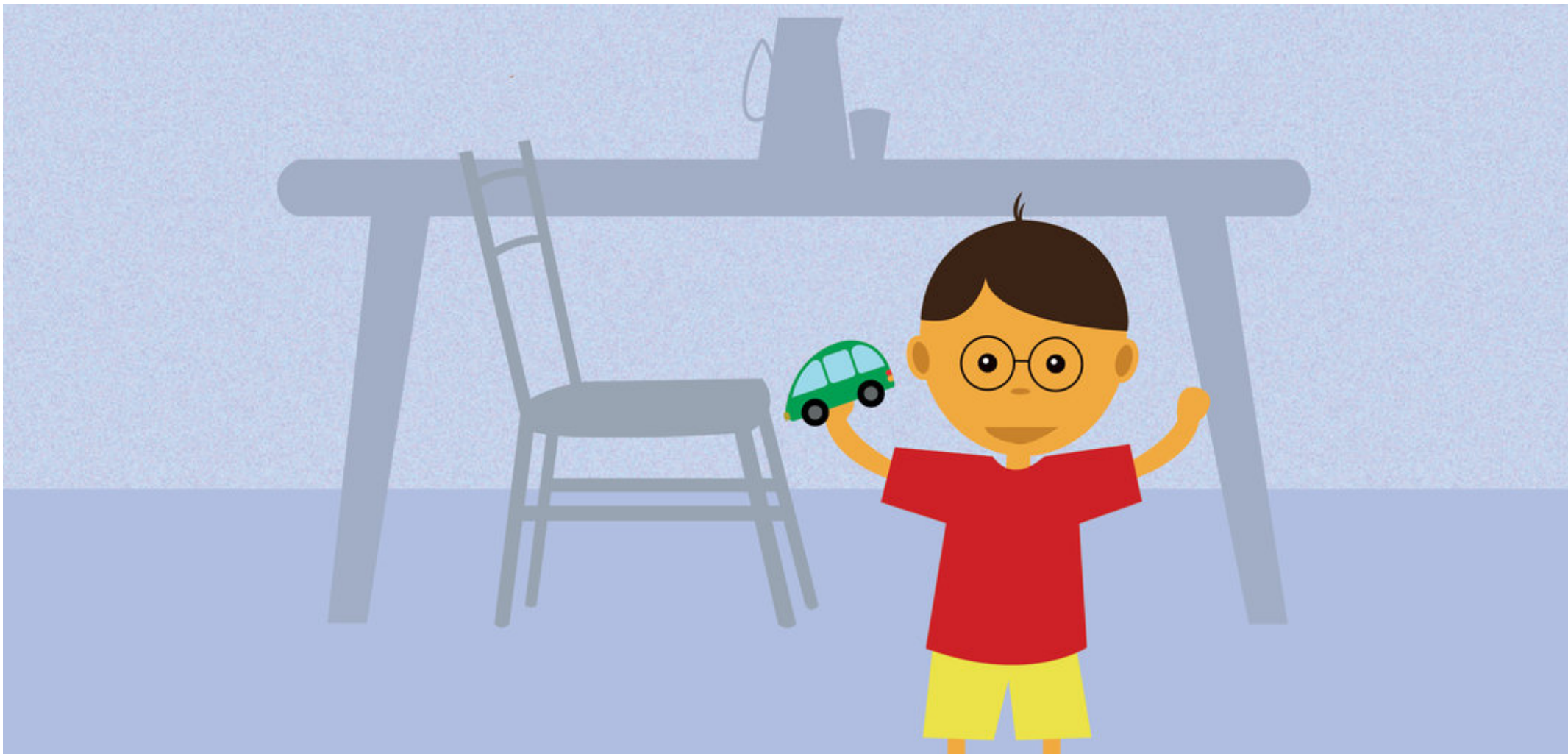
Papa laughs. “Sonu, learn to climb down!” he says.

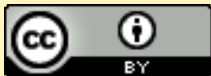
